This Privacy Notice applies to the processing of data related to the use of the webpage <https://dimerix.com/> (hereinafter "the Webpage").

Dimerix Limited and its related bodies corporate (hereafter 'DIMERIX') recognises the importance of protecting the privacy and the rights of individuals in relation to their personal information. This notice outlines our ongoing obligations to you in respect of how we manage your Personal Information.

DIMERIX as the Controller of the personal data, has committed to comply with:

- The General Data Protection Regulation N°EU 2016/679 (hereinafter, the "GDPR");
- The General Data Protection Regulation as it forms part of the law of England and Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland by virtue of section 3 of the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018 (hereinafter the "UK GDPR") and the UK Data Protection Act 2018 (amended 2020) (hereinafter the "Data Protection Act");
- All applicable European data protection laws.

Collectively referred as "Data Protection Laws".

With this Privacy Notice, DIMERIX wants to make sure that you understand what personal information is collected about you, how your personal information is used and how it is kept safe.

General warning and use of social media

Access to the Webpage implies the User's full and unreserved acceptance of this Privacy Notice (hereinafter the "Notice"), as well as its general terms of use.

The User acknowledges having read the information below and authorizes DIMERIX to process, in accordance with the provisions of the Notice, the personal data that he/she communicates on the Webpage.

The Notice is valid for all sub-pages hosted on the Webpage. It is not valid for the pages hosted by third parties to which DIMERIX may refer and whose privacy policies may differ. DIMERIX cannot therefore be held responsible for any data processed on these websites or by them. This Notice also applies to any other website that DIMERIX may operate, including our Company pages on Twitter and LinkedIn.

1. Why, how and for how long do we collect your personal data?

Depending on the purpose for which we process your personal data, we need to process one or more personal data. We will keep them for no longer than necessary to fulfill the purposes for which we collected it, including any legal requirements.

Depending on each case, the processing will therefore be as follows. Please note that only the processing listed below are done by DIMERIX as Controller. For other activities, such as the use of the cookies on the website, BLISS is considered the sole Controller.

Please note that other Personal Data may be processed by DIMERIX depending on your request and the information you provide us. We understand that the processing of these data is also beneficial to you to the extent that it enables us to assist you adequately and answer to the queries raised.	We will process your data for the time necessary to meet your request.
To send you newsletters or notifications	Name, email address.	This processing is based on your consent. Please, remember that you may unsubscribe from the Newsletter at any time without any cost.	We will process your data until you unsubscribe or cancel your subscription to the Newsletter.
To organize your participation in one of our events	Name, email address, financial details, phone number.	This processing is based on our contractual obligations or other legal ground when applicable upon the requirements of laws	We will process your data related to your subscription for the time necessary for the organization of your participation to one of our events.

2. Data sharing

We do not sell or trade to outside parties your personal data.

Nevertheless, DIMERIX has contracted with the following Services Providers to manage the Website that may have access to your personal data:

- BLISS for cookie storage and management of the whole website.
- Orient Capital for management of the Dimerix Investor Centre
- Link Digicom for management of DIMERIX Investor Relations communications

For EEA or UK residents only

Sharing your personal data as explained above may involve a transfer of personal data to a country outside the European Economic Area (EEA) and/or the UK. DIMERIX is therefore committed to comply with the transfer rules under applicable Data Protection Laws and therefore ensure to:

- Transfer your data to countries where the data recipient is located that has been recognized as adequate by the European Commission; by the ICO (Information Commissioner's Office (ICO)) or
- Where a country has not received an adequacy decision from the European Commission, or the ICO to implement appropriate safeguards, such as the EU Standard Contractual Clauses

("SCCs") (and the UK addendum), and/or the International Data Transfer Agreement ("IDTA").

3. How do we protect your information?

DIMERIX treats your personal data in a confidential manner and provides for a sufficient and adequate level of protection of your personal data.

Your personal data are contained behind secured networks and are only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems and are required to keep the information confidential.

4. Your rights

If you are an EEA or UK resident:

According to the GDPR, and/or UK GDPR you have the following rights:

- **Access.** You have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed, and, where that is the case, information related to the processing of data and a copy of the data being processed.
- **Rectification.** You have the right to require rectification of inaccurate data about you.
- **Right to be forgotten.** To obtain the deletion of your personal data in the situations set forth by applicable data protection law.
- **Restrict processing.** You have the right to restrict processing of data under certain specified circumstances.
- **Data portability.** You have the right to request for the receipt or the transfer to another organization, in a machine-readable form, of your personal data.
- **Object to processing.** You have the right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time to the processing of your data.
- **Right to withdraw consent.** When you have given your explicit consent for the processing of your data (e.g., Subscription to the Newsletter), you can withdraw it at any time without justification.

Please note that all these rights are not absolute and will be assessed on a case-by-case basis by our Data Protection Officer.

You have also the right to lodge a complaint if you consider that your personal data is not processed in accordance with the GDPR and the UK GDPR.

If you are an EEA resident: You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority in the Member State of the European Union of your habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement.

If you are a UK resident: you may file a complaint with the Data Protection Authority of UK ("ICO"), following the instruction available in the service channels.
